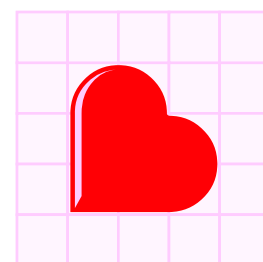


Ten Hearts

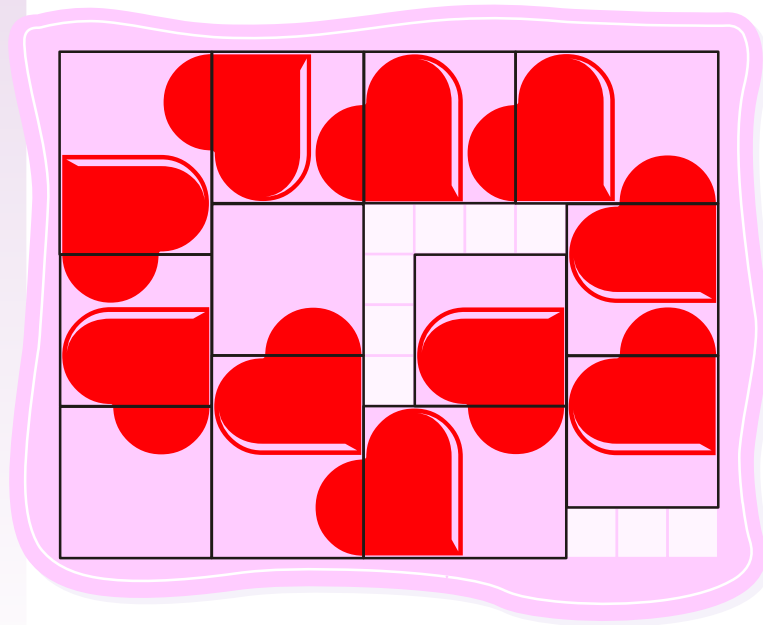
