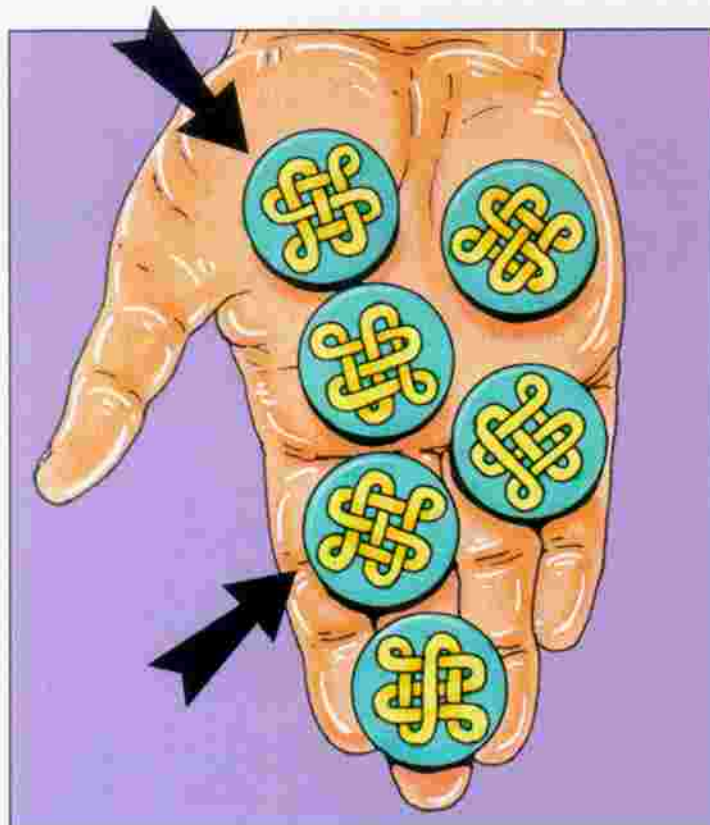


# VISUAL BRAINSTORMS®
