



**Answer:** There are four boys and three girls in the family.

**Here's how:** To start, we know that there is one more boy than girl, since Chad doesn't count himself as his own brother; and Blossom's sisters are one less than the total number of girls, since she wouldn't include herself in her count of sisters. Thus the number of Blossom's brothers (all the boys) minus two is the same as the number of her sisters; and since she has two times more brothers than sisters, she must have four brothers and two sisters.

**Bonus:** What imminent surprise does Blossom have in store for her brother?
